

INSTRUCTION

Required Observances (Veterans' Day, Constitution Day, and Temperance and Good Citizenship Day)

Principals shall be responsible for the preparation and presentation of educational activities of approximately sixty minutes in duration in observance of Veterans' Day. The program shall be conducted during the school week preceding the eleventh day of November of each year.

Constitution Day shall be observed each year on September 17th in commemoration of the September 17, 1787 signing of the United States Constitution. If September 17th occurs on a non-school day, Constitution Day shall be conducted on the preceding Friday.

Temperance and Good Citizenship Day shall be observed on January 16 or, if on a non-school day, the Friday preceding January 16.
