HB 1240 (2015-16) amended **RCW 28A.600.485** and expanded the prohibition of restraint and isolation to **all students**. It allows restraint or isolation of any student only when "reasonably necessary to control spontaneous behavior that poses an imminent likelihood of serious harm, as defined in RCW 70.96B.010." The provisions of the bill apply only to incidents of restraint or isolation which occur while a student is participating in school-sponsored instruction or activities. As a result of the legislation, the data collection around incidents of restraint or isolation is neither a **Special Education** nor a **Discipline collection**, but rather a **school safety-related** data collection.
